



Some marriages end in divorce. Others end violently. Irreversible explores the latter, but in this smart and taut action thriller with multiple twists and turns, the victims are not immediately discernable.

Ash and Alec were once inseparable. Now they're on a desert road trip off the beaten path to salvage their marriage. Almost immediately each sense that the other has an agenda far removed from reconciliation.

This becomes apparent when Alec arrives at a nearby desert camp alone and is greeted by Dylan, a Wall Street type who is out of step with the desert. It only takes a few minutes before Dylan realizes who Alec is, and in that moment Alec viciously beats Dylan senseless. Realizing what he has done, Alec retreats back to his own camp and Ash as if nothing has happened.

When Kat, an exotic unbalanced beauty, crashes her Jeep into their camp, it's not immediately clear whether Kat is a stranger at all. When Kat kidnaps Ash, it sets off a high octane chase through the desert that unravels the string of deceptions surrounding Dylan and his ultimate death, shifting the protagonists to antagonist, and putting the lives of all three in danger of being the next victim


With only four cast members, a hypnotic desert as its single location, and two 4x4's in action fueled starring roles, Irreversible is the classic action thriller.




















Irreversible revolves around four characters only, giving each actor an opportunity to immerse themselves in their multidimentional roles. The cast selects here are indicative of the type and calibre of actors sought. These and other actors will be approached for availability.



## DIRECTOR'S ent

I like entertaining audiences with all the classic elements of cinematic storytelling. But what turns me on even more is combining this with an engaging story, unexpected turns, and compelling characters that are relatable. This is what I watch, and what I intend with Irreversible.

The unexpected turns and unfolding dramatic tension play out against a surreal and formidible desert backdrop. I chose the desert, and specifically the Namibian Desert, because of its unparalleled scenic magic (could'nt build or scenic that), but also because it represents an omnipotent presence eyeing the actions and intentions of these four characters, a neutral observer that strips them of their daily distractions and comfort zones back in society. The desert will be treated with God-like cinematic reverence, using ultra-wide angles and slow sweeping pans.

Contrasted against this I incorporate handheld and stedicam throughout all the action and close work with cast and vehicles. I will not be using a dolly, crane, or similar grip gear. A drone will be used to capture aerials, especially in the final scene where the Landrover goes over the cliff. This final scene will be a combination of in camera, greenscreen (to put the cast in the action), and CGI.

While there are only four cast, the Landrover Defender (Betty) and 4x4 pick-up are also characters, every bit a protagonist and antagonist as Alec, Ash, Kat, and Dylan. The action sequences between these two vehicles is high octane, using a lot of handheld and car mounts. We will be attaching multiple 4K GoPros inside and outside the vehicles to capture amazing up close chase footage in the desert and canyons.

Irreversible is a classic edge-of-your-seat action thriller that grabs hold and never lets go. That is my intention with every scene, to engage and hold the audience through compelling storytelling pushed and supported by cinematic trickery!
